DOT Security Requirements - Additional Information

As reported in the March 2003 Fumigation Fax, the Department of Transportation (DOT) published a final rule (HM-232) "Hazardous Materials: Security Requirements for Offerors and Transporters of Hazardous Materials" (49 CFR 171-180) in the Federal Register, effective on March 25, 2003 (57 FR 14510). This rule, which requires the development and implementation of security plans and training, applies to anyone who ships or transports products containing methyl bromide or chloropicrin.

To assist shippers and transporters in enhancing hazardous materials transportation safety and security, DOT has provided website links to Security information and guidance documents. These documents include a Research and Special Programs Administration (RSPA) Security brochure and a Risk Management Self-Evaluation Framework that includes a template for developing security plans. RSPA is also offering a free CD-ROM that covers Hazmat Transportation Security Awareness Training. This CD can be ordered from DOT or downloaded on the DOT website.
