The deadline for submission of Critical Use Exemptions to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is **September 9, 2002**. Because of the complexity of the application process, many applicants are submitting joint applications through commodity associations/consortiums or grower organizations.

Submitting a CUE application is an important way to demonstrate to EPA your continued need for methyl bromide. Please let us know how we can help!
