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Methyl Bromide Heat Exchanger Update

As announced in February, Great Lakes has made a decision to discontinue providing the Whirl Wind Heat Exchanger to Meth-O-Gas[®] and Brom-O-Gas[®] customers.

Customers affected by this decision should contract a n alternative supplier to provide or fabricate an exchanger that will meet your needs. Heat exchangers should be designed, fabricated or modified to meet all federal and state engineering code standards and fire codes. The best way to ensure this is to contract an established engineering firm or industrial equipment supplier that deals with heat exchangers or vaporizers.

Sources for fabrication or modification of heat exchangers suitable for methyl bromide use include:

- ? Industrial waterbath and steam vaporizers companies, such as Gas Plants, (800-432-8538; www.gasplants.com). (These companies might be able to adapt their liquid propane gas vaporizers to be suitable for vaporization of methyl bromide.)
- ? Industrial heat exchanger equipment/engineering firms
