2002 Meth-O-Gas® Applicator Education Program

In 2000, Great Lakes instituted a training requirement for purchasers of our Meth-O-Gas® products. This program has been extremely successful, resulting in the training of over 1500 applicators.

The education program requires that Meth-O-Gas® applicators complete training certification every two years. Therefore, most of the applicators who attended a 2000 training session must attend refresher training by July 2002. Please check your Training Certificate card expiration date and contact your supplier for information on refresher training. If your training expires this year, you must attend a 2002 training session to continue purchasing Meth-O-Gas® products.

We have made significant changes in the Meth-O-Gas® Applicator Education Program for 2002. The focus is still first and foremost on the safe use and handling of the products, but the presentation has a new look, will incorporate additional interactive activities, and will include discussion of issues surrounding the phase-out of methyl bromide.

We have also revised the Meth-O-Gas® "Train-the-Trainer" program for 2002 by improving training tools and raising the level of requirements for trainers. Meth-O-Gas® trainers must complete a Great Lakes Trainer workshop during the first part of 2002 to requalify as trainers. Upcoming "Train-the-Trainer" workshop dates and locations will be announced in April.
